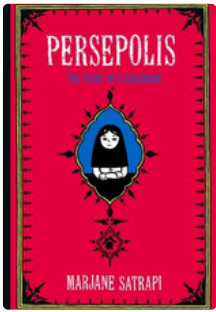


LORE OLYMPUS

Marjane Satrapi

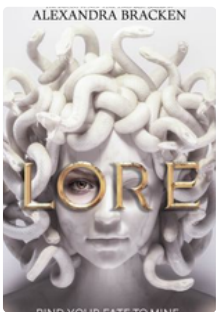
